3. **Relationship Legacy:** How will my key relationships (family, mentees) describe my influence?
4. **Contribution Audit:** What unique gifts will I deploy? What if I underuse them?
5. **Obstacle Forecast:** What barriers might derail this? How will I adapt?
6. **Milestone Mapping:** Break into 1-, 5-, and 10-year markers.
7. **Wild Card:** If resources were unlimited, what bold legacy would I pursue?
8. **Integration Check:** Does this align with my energy and rhythms?
9. **Accountability:** Who will I share this with for feedback?
10. **Refinement:** Revisit in 6 months—what's evolved?

Checklist for Use:

- Answer honestly, without self-editing.
- Connect to your strengths (cross-reference with other Valor tools).
- Turn insights into 3 actionable steps.

Closing: Legacy starts today. This guide turns reflection into direction.
